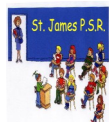

**New Ciborium.** At the 10:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, New Year's Day, 2012, the members of the late Lewis and Dorothy L. (Martin) Hornsey family presented a set of Holy Communion ciborium (dishes) to St. James Parish. The family members were commended by the pastor for their foresight and insight into providing a useful and necessary memorial gift to the parish. At the time of the mother's death, the family placed a notice in the obituary, "in lieu of flowers, please send memorial contributions to the St. James Catholic Parish." In addition, funds were used from their mother's estate to help purchase the two ciborium.

Lewis A. Hornsey died on Nov.26, 1998; Mrs. Dorothy L. (Martin) Hornsey died on May 28, 2011. The Hornsey siblings attended the Mass, and carried the "new" vessels, chalice, bread host and cruets of wine in the offertory procession. A "Star" bearer led the procession with two altar servers carrying processional candles. The ciborium were blessed by a ritual of holy water, before being used for the very first time to contain the "Body of Christ". (Usually a crucifix on a pole leads processions, but at the Christmas nativity, the crucifix is replaced by the lighted "Star of Bethlehem".) Shown are the Hornsey siblings from left; Jeanette Allen (Leawood, KS); Elaine Henry (Wildwood, Mo.); Jim Hornsey, (Greenwood, AR); pastor Fr. Joe Welschmeyer; Margaret Williams (Chesterfield, Mo.) and Carmen Wilberg (Dublin, CA). Edward Hornsey of Rolla, Mo. was unable to be present for the presentation.
