ARCHDIOCESES' ANNUAL RELIGIOUS INSTITUTE

St. James Parish has four organists as liturgical musicians in our local parish, as well as several guitarists who help on occasion.

There are also 23 men and women involved with our Parish School of Religion (CCD) classes. There are ushers, greeters, Eucharistic ministers, lectors, altar servers, choir members, church cleaners. Together, these persons make "the difference" in our parish worship and the religious education and sacramental preparation of our youth.

Imagine our numbers, placed aside those 1,700 principals, religious educators, catechists, day school teachers and liturgical musicians who gathered at our archdioceses' annual religious institute on August 7th. You may be unaware of such institutes, but they are held each year in August, before the beginning of the new school term. These Institutes are held at St. Louis University. They offer updating, continued education and formation to parishes throughout eleven counties of our Archdiocese of St. Louis, Mo.

Outside we can use younger men and married men who cannot attend the festival, to come and help us put away the booths, etc. into storage for next year's festival.

May each parishioner always strive thru prayer and offering your help, to make the 2011 Parish Fall Festival our best festival yet! Our parish campus is a sacred space, let's make our parish campus a showplace to the community by our hospitality and festive spirit. Being Catholic has its festive fun times as well as our serious times.
