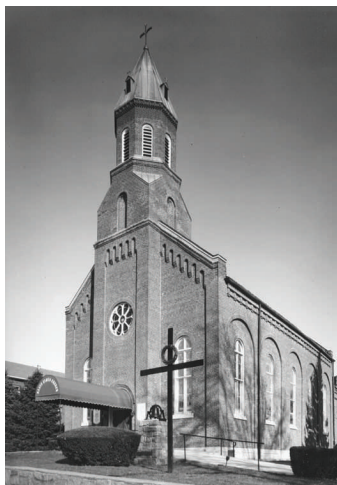

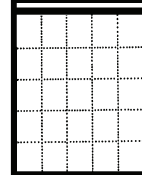

He is the patron saint of physicians and doctors, psychologists, therapists, physical therapists, dentists, pharmacists, chiropractors, and nurses- - RN and LPN, , allied health professions and health care employees and other medical workers, technicians, Washington County Memorial Hospital and area nursing home care employees, ambulance district and First Responders in our community; as well as secretaries and clerical workers in these professions. Physicians' assistants, and emergency personnel and their family members are invited to attend.
